“P” PAUSE

(Slowing and Centering, Silence, Stillness, and Waiting)

A Prayer to Pause - *Lord, as we enter prayer now, we pause to be still; to breathe slowly and to re-center our scattered senses on your presence; Holy Spirit, be our teacher, and we dive into Your Word together, Would you awaken our hearts, expand our minds and shape our identity into you today. We rejoice in your creativity and splendor, and the promises you gave to your people through your servant Saint Peter in 1 Peter 2, verses 9 and 10,...*

Pause Verse - 1 Peter 2:9-10

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

“R” REJOICE and REFLECT

(Adoration and Thanksgiving)

Monday - November 16th: Psalm 83:1-4, 9-10, 17-18; Romans 2:1-11

Wednesday - November 17th: Psalm 9:1-14 Matthew 24:45-51

Friday - November 20th: Psalm 100; Revelation 22:1-9

"A" ASK

(Presenting our Needs/Hurts/Laments/Requests to the Lord)

THE LORD'S PRAYER into continued healing from the global pandemic –

Hallowed be Thy name... Pray into the glory of God; worshipping God with adoration and honor.

I will extol you, my God the King; and bless your name for ever and ever.

Every day I will bless you and praise your name forever and ever.

Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised; his greatness is unsearchable. Psalm 145:1-2

Thy kingdom come... Pray for more of God's kingdom here on Earth. Pray for more of the acknowledgement of God as the sovereign ruler of our lives, our nation and world.

I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.
John 15:5-8

Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven... Pray for God's plan to be accomplished and for our submission to His leading, in total trust and obedience.

And this is love: that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.
2 John 1:6

Give us this day, our daily bread... Pray for God's provision and to rest in Him alone.

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
Philippians 4:6-7

And Forgive us our trespasses... Pray for a heart of forgiveness, beginning with confession and repentance. Pray to humbly confess sin, repent, turn from sin and ask for God's forgiveness. and restoration.

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar and his word is not in us. 1 John 1:8-10

As we forgive those, who trespass against us... Pray for the ability to forgive others; for God's help in forgiving others and living a life of love.

Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. Colossians 3:12-14

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil... Pray for protection from evil; for help and protection from sin and temptation.

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6:10-17

"Y" YIELD

(Surrender, Contemplation and Listening)

Yielding Prayer - David's Prayer in 1 Chronicles 29:10-13

David praised the Lord in the presence of the whole assembly, saying,

*'Praise be to you, LORD, the God of our father Israel,
from everlasting to everlasting.*
